DELAYS BEYOND CONTROL OF PARTIES: There shall be no liability upon either party to this agreement because of delay in delivering or in receiving materials due to weather conditions, war, fire, strike, riots, lockouts, civil commotions, cessation or stoppage of labor, extraordinary breakdowns, acts of God, and any other causes reasonably beyond the control of either party.
- 10. FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT AND INDEMNIFICATION: Seller agrees to comply with and to abide by the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 as amended and any other federal or state laws now in force or which hereafter may become effective or may be enacted and Seller agrees to defend Buyer and to hold Buyer harmless from any and all loss, cost, liability or damage by reason of the failure of the Seller or those hired or employed by Seller to comply with said laws. Certificates of each of the above policies together with a statement by the issuing company to the effect that said policies will not be canceled without a minimum of thirty (30) days' notice given to the Buyer.
