Dear Superintendent,

I have great news to share with you -- the Rural Regional College of Northern Pennsylvania has now been fully funded and has been given, "preferred status and be considered ordinary expenses of state government." (House Bill 1606 of 2016, Section 1901.2-G. Appropriations.) With that legislative language, the Rural Regional College is now permanently established and shall be included in every state budget from this point forward.

Contained within that legislation as well, the RRC Board of Trustees have been given a December 31, 2016, due date for the submission of the college plan to the Pennsylvania Department of Education. Many other activities shall also be occurring such as the search process for the new President, CFO, and other officers of the college. It is hoped that the President and others be in place by March 2017. Additionally, a Public Relations firm is being sought to begin marketing the college with the purpose of making the public more aware of this new post-secondary opportunity within the region. Lastly, with the tentative opening date of September 2017, site selections and the transition plans for those students currently enrolled in the ECUA/Gannon University Associate Degree Program are also being made.

None of this would have been possible without the strong support of our legislators, the public, and the school districts within the nine counties served by this new Rural Regional College. As a reminder, I have attached a copy of the Resolution that we ask your school district to adopt as a sign of your continuing support of this long overdue opportunity so that this new college can provide an affordable, accessible post-secondary education for our students and members of the public within their home communities.

I urge you to send your signed Resolution to me at the address below as soon as possible. Should you or the members of your board of education have any questions regarding the status of the RRC, ECUA, or the Resolution, I would be happy to come and meet with you at your convenience.
